GRAVESEND OLD TOWN HALL

The original town hall was erected in 1573 and in 1817 two covered colonnades were added, with the current entrance built in 1836.

In April 1969, the last public social function was held and the magistrates court was closed on 9th June 2000.

The building remained closed until 2010 when a regeneration plan was instigated. The building was totally remodelled and refurbished to an extremely high standard, the main function hall boasting six magnificent refurbished period chandeliers.



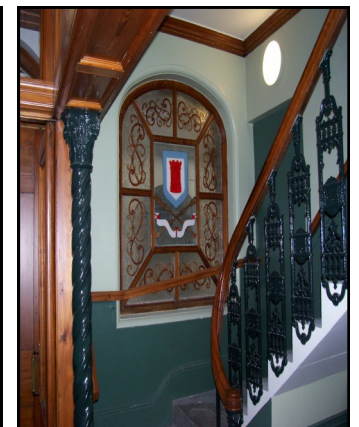
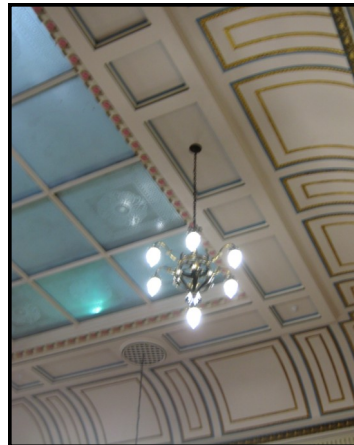
